Total Revenue Budget

£197,555

73.9% of the budget comes from council taxpayers and is known as the precept. The Parish Council does not receive any portion of the business rates nor government grants

15.69% of the budget from fees and services such as hall hire and allotment income

10.41% of the budget will be from Parish Council reserves to enable financial adjustments without increasing the budget

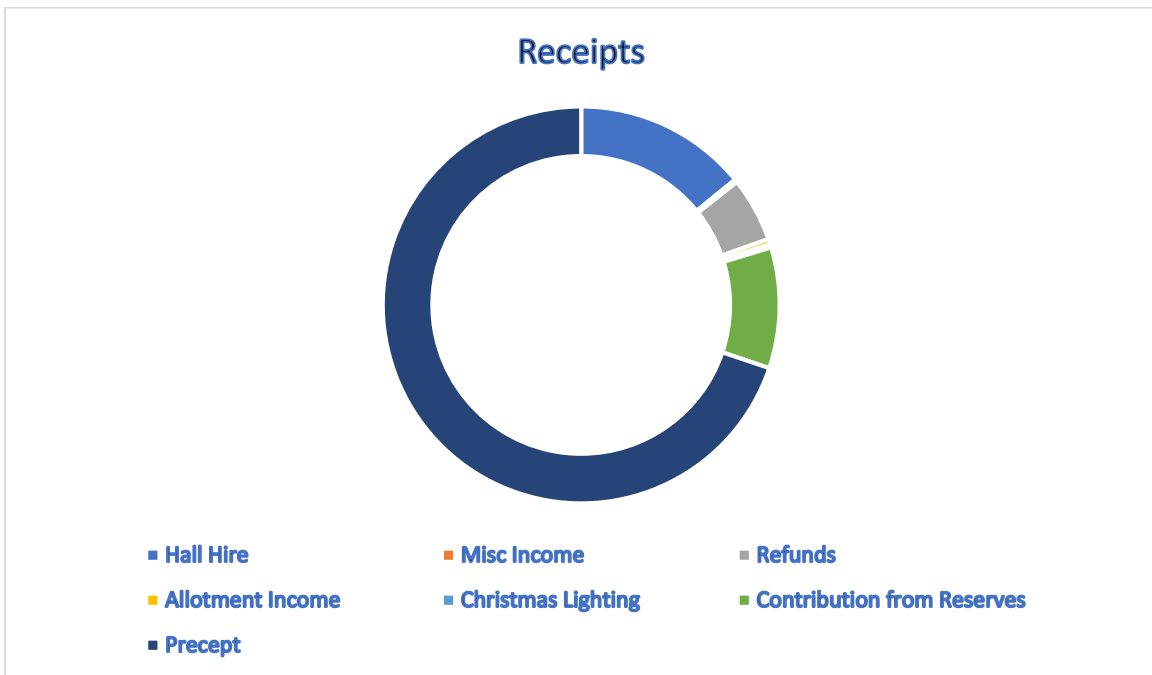
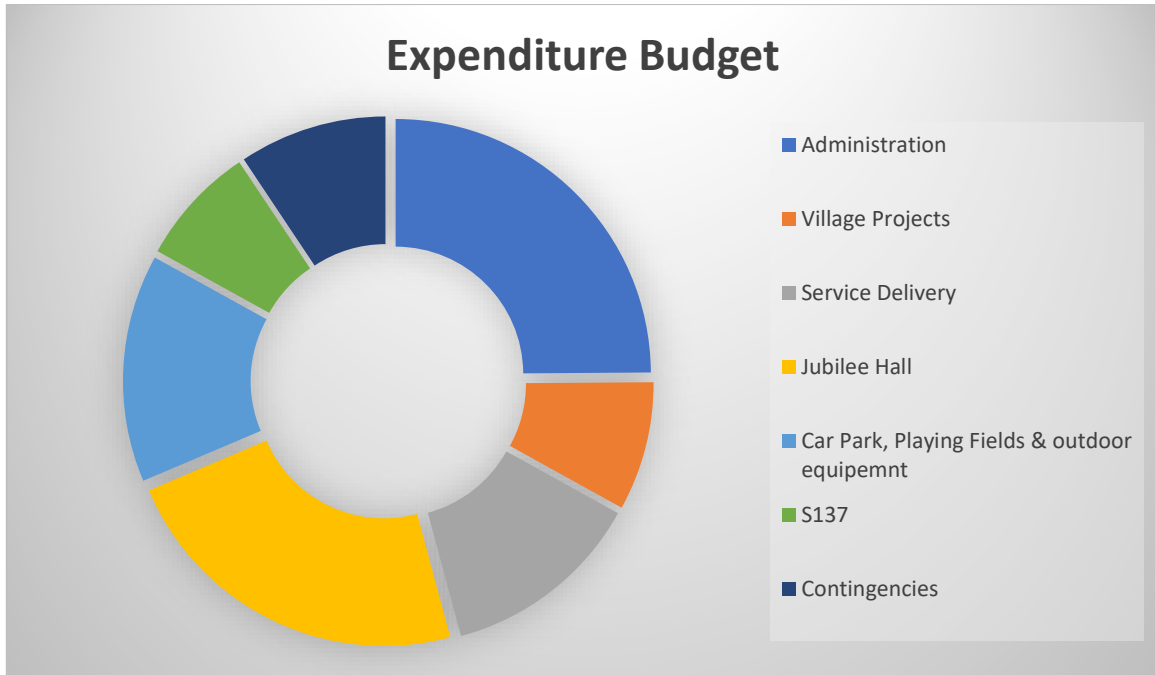

Wherever possible, the council aims to provide community facilities at zero net cost to reduce the burden on local taxpayers. However, exceptions enable community facilities to continue to be provided even if not commercially viable. This includes maintenance of public open spaces and play areas which do not generate income as they are free for public use.
