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# Y2 CREW

## Summer Scheme

**Y2 Crew is a referral scheme for residents of Tonbridge and Malling and run as a partnership between Tonbridge and Malling Early Help & Preventative Services and Tonbridge & Malling Borough Council, with funding from Parish Councils, Tonbridge Lions Club, the Community Safety Unit and Safer Kent.**

The scheme provides a wide range of activities with something to suit all ages and abilities, so why not experience a summer with a difference!

**The programme operates weekdays from Monday 26 July to Friday 13 August 2021.**

Each activity is led by qualified instructors and youth workers all of whom are vetted by the Disclosure and Barring Service where appropriate and trained in basic first aid.

Due to Covid-19 a reduced Y2 Crew programme is being offered this year. All the activities will be free of charge, but unfortunately there will be no transport provided and no trips taking place. The emphasis will be on outdoor local activities which will mean they will be weather dependant and may have to be cancelled at short notice.
