

## **Footway Lighting Policy:**

Our policy is as follows:

We will continue to maintain existing footway lighting which complies with the following criteria:

- a) The light must be in a settlement, that is, an area or location where there are residences;
- b) The footway being lit must link the community to an amenity or facility for public use (such as a shop or school) in a settlement;
- c) There must be no other complementary lighting to the footway from lighting to a footway or highway provided by a third party (for example the Highway Authority);
- d) The need for the footway light would be based on a suitable and sufficient assessment taking account of risks, the nature of the location, the number of lights required, road safety or crime and disorder issues, the extent of use of the footway & any other relevant consideration.
- e) We will continue to consider requests for new lights
